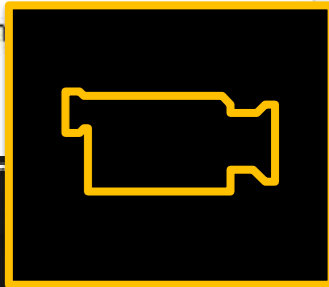

Funding Circle gets £40m from UK government

The UK's alternative finance industry has taken another step along the road to mainstream acceptance with the promise of a £40m investment from the British government.

Funding Circle, one of the UK's largest [peer-to-peer platforms](#), will use the money to provide more loans to small and medium-sized businesses over the next year.



The funding, which comes from the government's new [British Business Bank](#), follows a £20m state investment in the London-based company last year.



Instead of picking and choosing which businesses receive funding, the government will let Funding Circle allocate the money, but will provide 10 per cent of every loan the platform grants.
